Who can apply?

To be eligible for funding, you must be a Canadian organization or group, democratically held and managed, and in good standing. The following organizations are eligible for funding:

- Indigenous not-for-profit organization;
- Indigenous governing body such as a council, government or other entity that is authorized to act on behalf of an Indigenous group, community or people that holds rights recognized and affirmed by section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982;
- Indigenous ad hoc committee that has formed to do a specific project;
- For-profit Indigenous organization, provided that the project for which you are requesting funding will not result in income generation for your sole benefit;
- Indigenous-led institution including accredited programs; and
- In exceptional circumstances to be approved by the Program, non-Indigenous not-for-profit organization, in close partnership with Indigenous organizations.

Eligible activities

Your project must include community-driven objectives such as:

- Cultural development;
- Language reclamation, promotion, revitalization, maintaining and strengthening;
- Leadership development towards Indigenous languages;
- Life skills and wellness that incorporate learning of an Indigenous language;
- Innovation and new technologies;

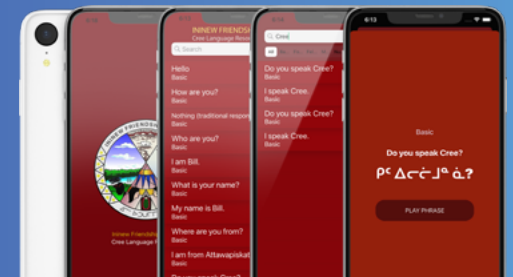

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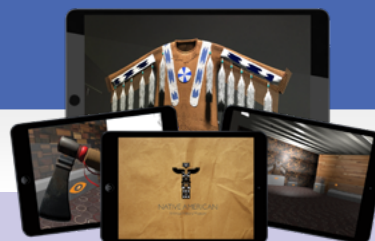
